

Regulations Governing Early Graduation Application for Undergraduates

Passed in the fourth Academic Affairs Meeting of 2003-2004 academic year on Nov. 4, 2003
Letter Tai Gao Zi (II) Zi No. 0930022674 permitted for reference by Ministry of Education on Mar. 9, 2004

Article 1. These Regulations are established in accordance with paragraph 2 and 3 of Article 23 of “University Act” and paragraph 2 and 3 of Article 41 of the NUK Academic Regulations.

Article 2. In accordance with the NUK Academic Regulations, students of bachelor programs who, during the period of study, meet the following criteria may apply to graduate one academic year or one semester earlier.

- (1) Completing all the courses and credits required for graduation
- (2) Attaining an academic grade average of 80 or above in each semester
- (3) Ranking within top 10 percent of the total number of the same grade in the department academically in each semester.

Article 3. Applicants who transfer from other universities to study in the third year at NUK can not apply for early graduation due to the term of study at NUK is short.

Article 4. Applicants shall issue the application for early graduation within one month since the course adding and dropping process ends.

Article 5. The regulations are passed in the Academic Affairs Meeting, and then reported to MOE for any possible examination, and then announced to carry into execution. When there is a need to make amendments, the procedure is the same as the aforementioned.
