

National University of Kaohsiung Regulations for Encouraging Undergraduates to Study for NUK Master Programs

Passed in the 84th Administrative Meeting on September 28, 2007

Amended and passed in the 93th Administrative Meeting on October 24, 2008

Amended and passed in the 131th Administrative Meeting on May 10, 2013

Article 1. National University of Kaohsiung (hereafter NUK) established the regulations in order to encourage NUK undergraduate students to continue studying in NUK for their masters programs.

Article 2. The students whom the regulations are established to encourage are those excellent students admitted through NUK's screening test or regular entrance examination for master programs. The research-oriented universities referred to in the forthcoming articles include National Taiwan University, National Cheng Kong University, National Tsing Hua University, National Chiao Tung University, National Yang Ming University, National Central University, National Sun Yat-sen University, National Chung Hsing University, National Chengchi University, National Taiwan University of Technology, and National Chung Cheng University.

Article 3. The types of scholarships, the amount of money, and the requirements are regulated as follows:

(1) Outstanding prize:

A. Qualifications

Students who are admitted as the first place through NUK's screening test or regular entrance examination for master programs, who are also admitted as the first place in the master programs of other research-oriented national universities, and who have enrolled. When these students apply for the prize, the relevant documents should be submitted.

B. Amount of the scholarship

The amount of the scholarship is one hundred thousand dollars (awarded fifty thousand dollars in the first semester of the first two years after the enrollment).

(2) Excellent prize

A. Qualifications

- a. Students who are admitted as the first place through NUK's screening test or regular entrance examination for master programs, who are also admitted in the master programs of other research-oriented national universities, and who have enrolled. When these students apply for the prize, the relevant documents should be submitted.
- b. Students who are not admitted as the first place through NUK's screening test or regular entrance examination for master programs, who are also admitted as the first place in the master programs of other research-oriented national universities, and who have enrolled. When these students apply for the prize, the relevant documents should be submitted.

B. Amount of the scholarship

The amount of the scholarship is sixty thousand dollars (awarded thirty thousand dollars in the first semester of the first two years after the enrollment).

(3) Special prize

A. Qualifications

- a. Students who are admitted through NUK's screening test or regular entrance examination for master programs, who are also admitted in the master programs of other research-oriented national universities, and who have enrolled. When these students apply for the prize, the relevant documents should be submitted.
- b. Students who are admitted as the first place through NUK's regular entrance examination for master programs and have enrolled in NUK.

B. Amount of the scholarship

The amount of the scholarship is twenty thousand dollars (awarded ten thousand dollars in the first semester of the first two years after the enrollment).

Article 4. Within the second week after the first semester begins, each

department/institute should send the list of the prize-winners and their related proving documents to the Division of the Academic Affairs for the processing of awarding scholarships.

Article 5. If the prize winner applies for Leave of Absence after the enrollment, the scholarship will not be provided until their readmission. If the prize winner applies for expulsion, the scholarship will not be provided. If the application for Leave of Absence or expulsion is approved in the middle of a semester, the scholarship granted doesn't need to be returned. The prize winners regulated here can apply for other scholarships in accordance with the other relevant regulations in NUK.

Article 6. The scholarships regulated here are paid by **the School Affair Fund**.

Article 7. Any matter that is not fully provided for under these Regulations shall be in accordance with the Enforcement Rules established later, which shall be passed in the Administration Meeting, and then announced to carry into execution.

Article 8. The regulations are passed in the Administration Meeting, and then announced to carry into execution. When there is a need to make amendments, the procedure is the same as the aforementioned.
